


Cold n Store Refrigerator Slideout





Apply double-sided adhesive tape as illustrated above. Position and align the unit on its side and line the side of the track parallel to the side of the unit. Firmly press together. Repeat this for necessary spacers* and for both sides of the unit.





Now attach to glass shelving in the desired location with the top adhesive strip and press firmly.

Remove unit from slides and press the slides firmly onto the glass shelf.

Re-install unit onto the stack slides. You are now ready to organize your refrigerator. Cold n Store slideout unit holds 19, quart-size zip lock bags or similar size pre-packaged food items.

- 1 - Cold n Store slideout unit
- 8 - Double-sided adhesive strips
- 2 - Track slides
- 4 - Shelf spacers
- 1 - Metal rack installation hardware pack (for those that have metal shelving)

NOTE: Clean and dry underside of glass shelf and plastic unit prior to installation.

* To determine if two or four spacers are needed for your refrigerator: If the space between the lip of the shelf and the track is 1/2 inch or less, two spacers are needed, one per side. If the space between the lip of the shelf and the track is 1/2 inch or more, four spacers are needed, two per side.

** You will need 4 machine screws, 4 square nuts, 4 nylon spacers, 4 washers and an Allen wrench (all included). Slide the square nuts into each slot on the top of the unit spacers. Place the unit in desired location. Put the machine screw down through the washer, the refrigerator shelf and the nylon spacer loosely screwing into the square nut. Repeat these steps for the remaining three corners. Level the unit and tighten accordingly with the Allen Wrench.

Cold n Store Refrigerator Door Storage

Align adhesive tape to both sides of the Cold n Store unit and apply.

Remove the liner from the top of the adhesive tape and position the Cold n Store unit directly under the desired fridge door shelf and firmly press the shelf and the Cold n Store unit together.





Cold n Store holds 10 quart-size zip lock bags or similar size pre-packaged food items.

- 1 - Fridge Door Cold n Store unit
- 1 - Double-sided adhesive strips

NOTE: Clean and dry underside of glass shelf and plastic unit prior to installation.

Dry n Store Cabinet Slideout

Apply double-sided adhesive tape as illustrated above. Position and align the unit on its side and line the side of the track parallel to the side of the unit. Firmly press together. Repeat this for both sides of the unit.

Now attach to underside of the cabinet shelving in the desired location with the top adhesive strip and press firmly.



3

Remove unit from slides and press the slides firmly onto the cabinet shelf. Use the 4 screws provided for additional support if needed.

Re-install unit onto the cabinet shelving. You are now ready to organize your dry foods. Dry n Store slide-out unit holds 12 quart-size zip lock bags or similar size pre-packaged food items.



- 1 - Fridge Door Cold n Store unit
- 2 - Track slides
- 1 - Double-sided adhesive strips
- 1 - Pack of 4 screws

NOTE: Clean and dry underside of glass shelf and plastic unit prior to installation.

Freeze n Serve Freezer Food Tray



Freeze n Serve tray individually portions your foods.

1 For soup, gravies and other liquids, a 1-gallon bag holds 4½ cups and a 1-quart bag holds 1¼ cups. For meats, spaghetti and other foods, a 1-gallon bag holds 36 ounces and a 1-quart bag holds 14 ounces.

2 Place two quart bags or one gallon bag on top of the Freeze n Serve tray and press down into each of the six compartments as evenly as possible.


Place tray in the freezer.

3 Once frozen, remove bag(s) from the Freeze n Serve tray and stack conveniently in your freezer.

4 Your foods are individually portioned and can now be easily separated. Just twist inside the zip lock bag to portion out the servings you need.

Chop n Fill Stand

Chop n Fill Mat Holder



- 1 - Stand base
- 1 - Stand leg
- 1 - Silicone feet 3 pack.

1 To assemble Chop n Fill place each of the feet as shown above by the blue arrows. Snap stand leg into stand base as shown.

2 Chop n Fill stand is designed to accommodate both gallon and quart cutting mats to help you fill gallon and quart size zip lock bags.

3 There are indents on each side of the mats that snap into place to hold either size mat securely as shown above for either a gallon mat (top view) or the quart mat (bottom view).


4 The wings on the cutting mat go inside the zip lock bag to help hold the bag and keep it partially open. Once the bag is in place pour the contents onto the mat and down into the bag.

- 1 - Freeze n Stack box
- 8 - Freeze n Stack inserts

1 The Freeze n Stack box holds 8 inserts with each insert holding 1 zip lock bag.

2 Place the inserts into the box and place a quart bag in each of the inserts for quick and easy filling.

3 Open each bag and place approximately 1¼ cups or 14 ounces of soup or other desired contents into each bag.

4 Fill all 8 bags and place in the freezer. Once contents are frozen remove to stack and organize in your freezer.
